- Our overarching aim remains to create sustainable, equitable opportunities that empower communities in Uttarakhand.




#### MISSION

### Background and Premise of our Initiative

AITYS was established to address the diverse socio-economic challenges in the rural areas of Uttarakhand, with a specific focus on education and health. The organization works primarily in the Pauri Garhwal region, providing vital support to underserved populations through holistic, sustainable initiatives.

Since 2012, AITYS has developed a reputation for delivering impactful, communitycentred programs, focused on enhancing educational access and supporting disasterstricken communities in recovering and rebuilding.





## Area of operations

AITYS operates across 347 villages in Uttarakhand, with primary activities centred between Devprayag and Pauri. Covering both the Pauri Garhwal and Almora regions, AITYS has maintained its commitment to meeting the educational, healthcare, and infrastructure needs of this diverse landscape. Despite challenges posed by geographic isolation and environmental issues, AITYS continues to provide essential resources to schools, students, and communities across these regions.



### Engagement with Stakeholders

#### **Schools as Partners**

Through partnerships with 40 schools, AITYS has established a collaborative approach to extend educational and healthcare services. Local teachers and village representatives play an instrumental role in our initiatives, acting as key facilitators of program awareness and coordination with families.

#### **AITYS as Facilitator for Students**

AITYS works closely with students, families, and school administrators to ensure smooth implementation of programs, maintaining consistent communication to overcome logistical challenges and meet each student's unique needs.

#### **Donors and Sponsors as Enablers**

Generous contributions from individual, corporate, and international donors have empowered AITYS to sustain and scale its programs. We remain profoundly grateful for the continued support that allows us to reach more people each year.



### **Key Highlights**

Through these achievements, AITYS has brought transformative changes to the communities it serves, providing a foundation for long-term growth and development.



### **Projects Undertaken**

#### Open College / Distance College Education

For the first time, AITYS extended its support to sponsor college education for 82 students who have completed secondary education. This new initiative provides financial assistance for distance and open college programs, enabling students from remote areas to access higher education and gain skills for future career opportunities. By supporting these students' college ambitions, AITYS is addressing critical barriers to education beyond high school, fostering opportunities for lifelong growth.



This year, AITYS provided educational support to 2,800 students across 40 schools, distributing books, school bags, tiffins, water bottles, and clothing. These resources not only alleviate financial pressure on families but also encourage regular attendance, contributing to a decrease in dropout rates.





### **Projects Undertaken**

#### Sustaining the Toiletiquette Project

AITYS constructed 24 toilet blocks, addressing a critical need for sanitation facilities in schools and promoting hygiene among students. This project continues to play a vital role in fostering an environment that supports students' health and education.

#### Persevering and Scaling the Gift a Pad Project

Our menstrual hygiene initiative distributed 45,000 sanitary pads and installed 19 incinerators in schools across the region, empowering girls to manage their menstrual health safely and with dignity, resulting in improved attendance rates.

#### **School Infrastructure Aid**

In fiscal year 2023–2024, AITYS expanded its infrastructure projects to improve learning environments across the Pauri Garhwal region. Key accomplishments include:

- 16 new classrooms and 4 laboratories for science and computer education
- 05 toilet blocks constructed, providing essential sanitation facilities
- O2 multi-purpose rooms and O3 playgrounds to promote holistic education







### Challenges

The ongoing challenge of changing perceptions around sanitation and menstrual health continues to require intensive community engagement. Additionally, geographic isolation, logistical limitations, and network issues in rural areas present challenges that demand creative solutions to ensure the continuity of AITYS's initiatives.

### Outcomes

Our work this year has reinforced the long-term benefits of education, healthcare, and infrastructure support in rural areas. AITYS's initiatives have significantly lowered dropout rates, improved student attendance, and fostered an inclusive, supportive environment for students to thrive academically and personally.

Through sustained partnerships and dedicated volunteers, AITYS has successfully expanded its reach, empowering communities and inspiring positive change across Uttarakhand. This year's addition of college sponsorship marks a milestone in our journey, as we continue to support students' aspirations beyond secondary education, laying the groundwork for a brighter, more prosperous future for all.


